

# ONE *Mission Faith*

The Archdiocese of Los Angeles is a tapestry of many peoples and cultures with a common thread joining us as one: one mission to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ and one Catholic faith to be believed, celebrated, and lived. **One Mission One Faith** is a basic ministry formation process for anyone who serves in the life of the Church.

The goal of **One Mission One Faith** is growth as a missionary disciple of Jesus Christ and formation as a parish minister. Participants will ground their ministry in a deeper understanding and intentional living of their Catholic faith. Participants can earn a certification from the Archdiocese of Los Angeles (Certification-Track), or they can participate simply for their ongoing development (Enrichment-Track).

## **PARTICIPANTS WHO COMPLETE THIS PROCES WILL:**

- Grow in love and knowledge of God
- Understand the Word of God and basic Catholic teachings
- Integrate the Word and Catholic teaching with life, prayer, and ministry
- Develop skills to serve effectively in ministry
- Share their faith in Jesus Christ with greater clarity and confidence

## **EACH SESSION ENTAILS:**

- Video presentations
- Readings
- Written reflections
- Prayer, small-group conversation, and Q&A (via live web conference)
- Accompaniment by a team of facilitators

The process occurs over five months, one online session per week (some sessions occur via live web conference). Integration sessions for prayer, small-group conversation, and Q&A occur between every few sessions via live web conference.
