2. PRAY

As a family, reflect on the gifts that you bring to the family. Each person is to think of one gift that they know they have.

Children: Draw a picture of you sharing your gift with your family, a neighbor, or a friend.

Teenagers: Record a short-clip describing what your gift is

Young Adults: Make a short-clip on how you would utilize your gift now to address a current issue in your family, neighborhood for the Common Good.

Adults: How are you witnessing with your gifts in all your relationships?

3. TALK

Talk with your family about these questions. If you live by yourself, call a close friend or a family member to talk to.

Children: Talk with your family about your drawing.

Teenagers: Share your clip and send it to your family members.

Young Adults: Share one thing you will do with your gifts for the Common Good.

Adults: Pray for your children or someone you know that their gifts will bear more fruit through service.
