

The Power of Home
Adoption and Foster Care
Grades 7-9

Goal: Students will learn about the number of infants and children available for adoption or in the foster care system. They will explore adoption as a loving option for unexpected pregnancies. Activities and personal testimonies will reinforce the need of each person to have stability, love, and family.

Lesson: Introduce the topic of adoption. Why are there children who need to be adopted? What is foster care? Why do families adopt or taken in foster children? Why are these stories of redemption? Do you know anyone who has been adopted, has adopted a child, or who has placed a child for adoption?

Watch: ["A Birthmother Story: Grace"](#) A birthmother shares her moving story of choosing adoption for her baby. Adoption is chosen because birthmothers love their children more, not less. 4 minutes.

[Jessica's Story](#) of being a birthmom and placing her child for adoption with a loving home. Jessica is an important part of her daughter Macy's life and her new adoptive family. 6 minutes.

Discussion: Why did these women choose adoption for their children?

Did it seem to be the right choice, or one they ever regretted?

Was it difficult?

How did other people view their choice to place for adoption?

Did they care what others thought?

Overall, did they seem happy with their decision?

Discussion: Why did these families choose to adopt children?

Did they start by wanting to adopt many children? Or just one?

Is there anything similar about these stories? What?

Overall, did the children seem happy to be adopted? Did the parents seem happy?

Watch: [The Dropbox](#) is an amazing idea one man created in South Korea to care for that nation's unwanted babies. 3 minutes.

Discussion: These videos chronicle an amazing story in South Korea of a man finding a solution to a problem in their culture.

What did you find most interesting about this story?

Why do you think people are drawn to this orphanage?

What did the camera crew learn while they were filming?

Activity: Ask students to choose one of the following perspectives and activities.

- A birthmom looking to place a child for adoption. Write a letter to your child giving your reasoning for choosing adoption and sharing with him or her your hopes for the future. Feel free to name your child and create descriptions of your life. This is your big chance to share your wisdom and love with your child!
- A couple wanting to adopt. Put together a portfolio of photos and stories explaining your life and why you think you would make great parents for an adopted child. Explain experiences from your own childhoods and whether you have other children or not. You want a birthmom to choose you!
- A child who has been adopted (either at birth or through fostercare). Write a letter to your birthmom telling her about your life now. How has your life changed since you have been adopted? Where do you live? Do you have siblings? Have you had to change a lot of things? What are your feelings toward your birthmom? Make sure to thank her for giving you the gift of life!
