# 3. PRAY

Reflecting on how God is present in our daily lives reminds us that we are not alone. We can get caught up in the realities of this world but our invitation from God is to share His love with everyone around us. Together, pray the litany of trust aloud. Pay attention to how God might be inviting you to trust in Him.

<u>Litany of Trust</u> (adapted from the Sisters of Life. You can find the longer litany <u>here</u>)

### From the belief that I have to earn Your love ... **Deliver me, Jesus.**

From refusals and reluctances in accepting Your will ... **Deliver me, Jesus.** 

From anxiety about the future ... Deliver me, Jesus.



From resentment or excessive preoccupation with the past ... **Deliver me, Jesus.** 

From disbelief in Your love and presence ...

Deliver me, Jesus.

From the fear of being asked to give more than I have ... **Deliver me, Jesus.** 

From discouragement ... Deliver me, Jesus.

That You are with me in my suffering ... Jesus, I trust in you.

That Your plan is better than anything else ... Jesus, I trust in you.

That You give me the grace to accept forgiveness and to forgive others ...**Jesus, I trust in you.** 

That You give me all the strength I need for what is asked ...Jesus, I trust in you.

That my life is a gift ... Jesus, I trust in you.

That You will teach me to trust You ...

Jesus, I trust in you.

That I am Your beloved one ... **Jesus, I trust in you.** Amen.
