Talk to Him about the questions you may have about His baptism or your own.

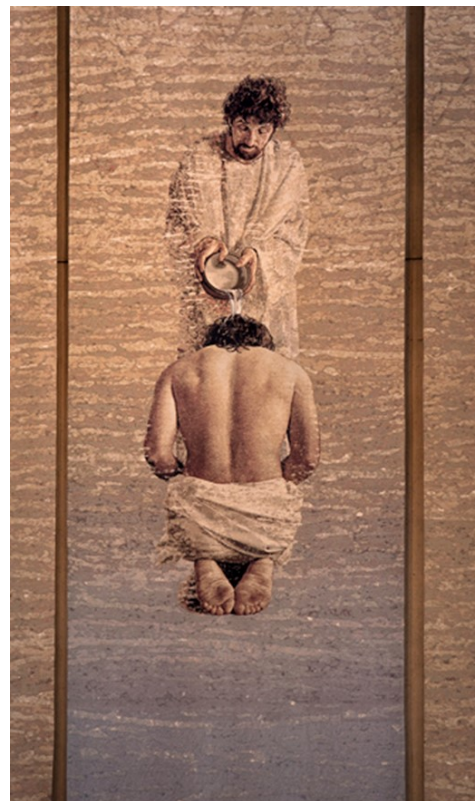
