3. TALK

As a family, discuss the following questions:

- Rich and poor are two terms with many interpretations. What are the things that make our family rich? How does this fit with the meaning Jesus intended?
- What meaningful action will I do this week to bring a smile to someone?

As a family, pray for all who experience rejection, denunciation or hostility. Pray that you may see in them what Jesus sees and consider what Jesus wants you to learn from them.
