1. HEAR

2. PRAY

Begin your prayer time by reciting the "Jesus Prayer":

When you breathe in say, "Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the Living God."

When you breathe out say, "Have mercy on me a sinner." Recite this three times.

We hear in the Gospel, that Jesus cautions us about being more concerned over the splinter in someone else's eye, rather than the beam in our own.

Talk with Jesus and ask him to help you identify your own blind spots in your eyes or in your heart.

Ask Jesus how you can live more like Him – to be more humane, humble, loving, compassionate and kind.

Ask Jesus what you might need to bring to the Sacrament of Reconciliation to cleanse your heart and soul from the times in your life where you have failed to live as Jesus asks us to live.
