2. PRAY

People, by definition, are dissatisfied beings who always thirst for something: water, wealth, happiness, power, love, justice, salvation.

Our thirst, deep down, is thirst for God. He is inviting us to seek Him and to meet Him.

Close your eyes. Imagine that you approach the well.

Share with us how you are living out your faith at home. Use #LACatholicsBelieve and tag @LACatholics on social media.

It is a well-known place where you often go to get water. It's hot... You are thirsty... You carry a pitcher in your hand... Suddenly, Jesus appears who sits next to you at the well. He asks you for water...



Listen to what he tells you... how he speaks to you... what he needs from you. Talk to him. What am I thirsty for? What do I need? What do I want to fill my life with? Now I let silence to be in me. I am simply present in God, as He is quietly present in me.

3. TALK

As a family, discuss the following questions:

- Do I find time to talk to my family members?
- Do I find time to talk to this OTHER with whom we share our lives?
- What is my life thirsty for? Am I thirsty for God?
- Who is the God of my life?

After her encounter with Jesus, the Samaritan woman lived a missionary experience inviting others to go to Jesus. During this week invite someone from the family or someone you know who has been away from the church to go with you to Mass the following Sunday.
