

**PREPARATION CHECKLIST:
CELEBRATION OF THE LORD'S PASSION
GOOD FRIDAY**

- The altar is completely bare.
- The Lectionary is prepared in the usual way on the ambo.
 - How many lectors are needed?
- The Book of the Gospel or Passion books are pre-set from where they will be read or at another convenient place.
 - It may be proclaimed by three persons who take the parts of Christ, the Narrator, and the People. The part of Christ should be reserved to the priest. If the Passion is proclaimed by only one reader, then it should be proclaimed by a deacon or priest.
- The missal is at the book-bearer's chair.
- If the Chapel of Repose was outside the main church, the usual tabernacle remains empty with the door conspicuously open. The vigil candle is removed and unlit.
- The font remains completely emptied (including any other dependent stoups and fonts)
- The paschal candle stand remains empty and placed near the empty font, or in its usual place, or removed entirely.
- One large cross is prepared for adoration by the faithful.
 - Where should it be placed before the liturgy and after the adoration?
- Candles may be prepared in the back of the church for the processions of cross and Blessed Sacrament.
- At the credence table:
 - Altar cloth
 - Corporal
 - Ciboria needed for distribution of Holy Communion.
 - (Lavabo, chalices, purificators, water cruet not needed.)
 - Humeral veil
- How many communion stations are needed? How many Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are needed?
- The worship aids are at the doors or given out by ministers of hospitality.
 - How many hospitality ministers are needed? Where they should be stationed?
- Basket for the collection for the Holy Land.
- Are altar servers needed?
