
#### 1. HEAR

#### 2. PRAY

As a household pray the Easter sequence. Have one member of the household read the sequence while everyone else listens. Create a prayer space with a candle lit while you listen to the sequence:



Christians, to the Paschal Victim
Offer your thankful praises!
A Lamb the sheep redeems;
Christ, who only is sinless,
Reconciles sinners to the Father.
Death and life have contended in that combat stupendous:

The Prince of life, who died, reigns immortal.

Speak, Mary, declaring

What you saw, wayfaring.

"The tomb of Christ, who is living,
