2. PRAY

Let us pray together:

Dear Lord,

You taught us how to pray, how to treat one another and to be holy disciples.

You taught us to be persistent, asking our Father for what we need and trusting that our prayers are heard and answered.

Help us to remember to pray always and call upon the Holy Spirit, confident in the love and mercy our heavenly Father will provide.

Amen.

3. TALK

Jesus's disciples asked him to teach them how to pray because John the Baptist had taught his followers to pray. By praying the Lord's Prayer, we become conscious of our relationship with God. Jesus is asking us, as disciples of Christ, to trust Him through prayer, "Give us this day, our daily bread", so that we may receive our daily dose of Jesus!

As a family, discuss the following questions. If you live by yourself, consider a meet up or phone conversation with another.

- What word or phrase speaks to you when you pray the Our Father?
- What other ways can we pray or speak with God?
- What is something that is important to you that you would pray for persistently?
