Heavenly Father,

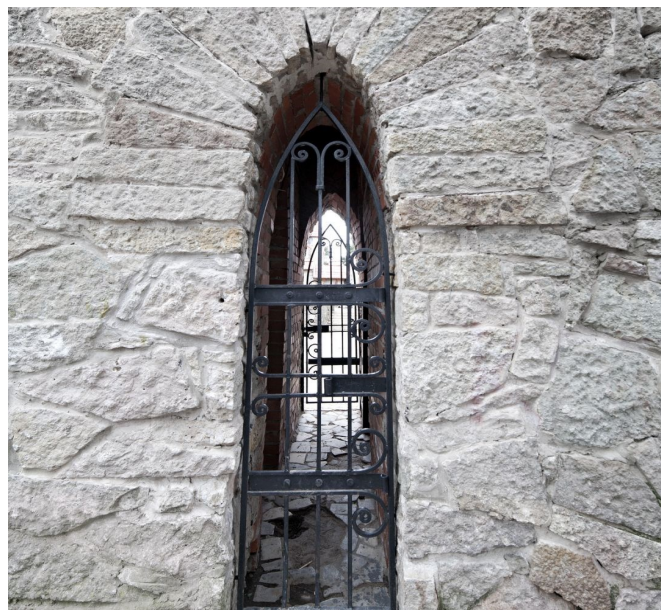
You love us so much that you treat us like your beloved sons and daughters, and just like a loving parent, you discipline us when we do not follow your commandments.
