## 2. PRAY

Talk with Jesus about the times you have wanted God to save you from the consequences of something you have done that was wrong. How did that make you feel? Listen for what Jesus tells you now about those times.

Talk with Jesus about the times you have recognized you did something wrong and asked God for his mercy and forgiveness. How did that make you feel? What is Jesus saying to you now about those times?

## 3. TALK

When you think about a king, what comes to mind? What does it mean to be a king? What are the responsibilities of a king?

In the Gospel, other people didn't understand what kind of king Jesus is. The rulers sneered at him; the soldiers jeered at him; one of the criminals who was crucified with Jesus wanted him to save them from the cross. But the other criminal understood that Jesus was an innocent man and a different kind of king.

What kind of King is Jesus? How is this different from the way we think about other kings? Why is this important for you personally?
