2. PRAY

In today's gospel, Jesus reaffirms the commandments from the Old Testament. But he takes it further, expanding on them. Jesus gives examples of model conduct of a disciple, by teaching about anger, lust, divorce, and oaths.

For today's prayer we invite you to practice an <u>examen</u> based on Jesus' teachings on the law.

- 1. Begin by quieting yourself and giving thanks to God for the blessings of your day
- 2. Ask God to enlighten you, showing where he has been at work and present in your day through events, people and places.



- 4. Talk to God about where He is challenging you to change and grow.

3. TALK

Jesus teaches his followers what it means to exceed the righteousness of the religious leaders of his day.
