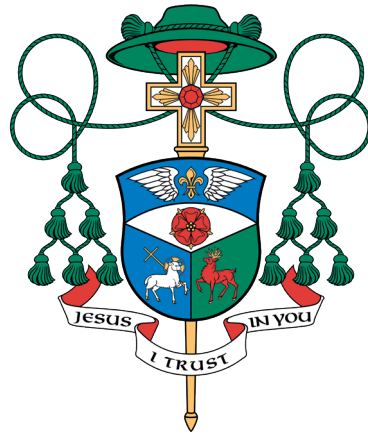

## MOTTO

In heraldry, a motto has been a personal philosophy of life as well as a family dictum, and sometimes even a cry for battle. But in Church heraldry, a cleric's personal motto has always been intended to represent his personal spirituality and theologically based philosophy of life and is most frequently grounded in Sacred Scripture or in a prominent prayer or litany. For Bishop David O'Connell, this symbolism is found on the banderole (motto ribbon) in five simple yet powerful words:

**JESUS I TRUST IN YOU**

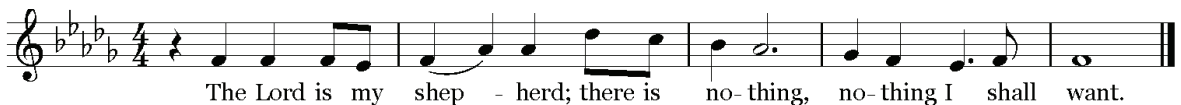




