# Updates to Catholic Bible Institute Cycles

CBI is shifting to a two-year cycle from the current one-year cycle. This means new applicants will be enrolled every two years, rather than every year. This process will begin in Fall 2023.

Only those who are currently enrolled in CBI in Year 1 will be eligible to register for the 2023-2024 year. We will accept people returning for recertification

### CATECHIST FORMATION

#### ADVANCE MINISTRY STUDIES

The Advanced Ministry Studies program is now accepting applications for the upcoming 2023-24 Catechetical/Ministerial Year in advanced studies. The formation is offered in a hybrid format, a combination of online Zoom Sessions, Moodle online, and in person classes (about 3 per year)

#### CERTIFICATION OPTIONS:

Upon completion of classes and a process of discernment, ministers will be commissioned and be certified with one of the following certifications in collaboration with the Catholic Conference of Bishops and the Archdiocese of Los Angeles:


