STEPS TO BECOMING A CERTIFIED CATECHIST

- Complete the Theology Phase I - One Mission One Faith - OMOF
- Complete Phase II Vision and Skills for faith Formation (former known as Specialization) This is a preparation to develop catechetical and ministerial skills for sharing faith offered through the Office of Religious Education.
Specialization Phase offered by Office for Worship, or another Archdiocesan ministerial office.*
- Complete the Practicum Phase
 - Observation: Do two observations to gain experience and be enriched by other facilitation styles - certified catechists.
 - Evaluation: Be evaluated one time by a certified master catechist, certified catechist, Parish Catechetical Leader, or office approved leader.
- Recommendation for certification by Pastor, Pastoral Associate or Parish Catechetical Leader DRE/CRE/PCL
- Assemble all completed paperwork, present it to your coordinator along with the Catechist Certification Progress Transcript form to be verified and signed by the coordinator on the Practicum Phase section. Once everything is completed email fluna@la-archdiocese.org to receive the link to the Catechist Certification Completed Paperwork Online Room to upload your paper work.
