

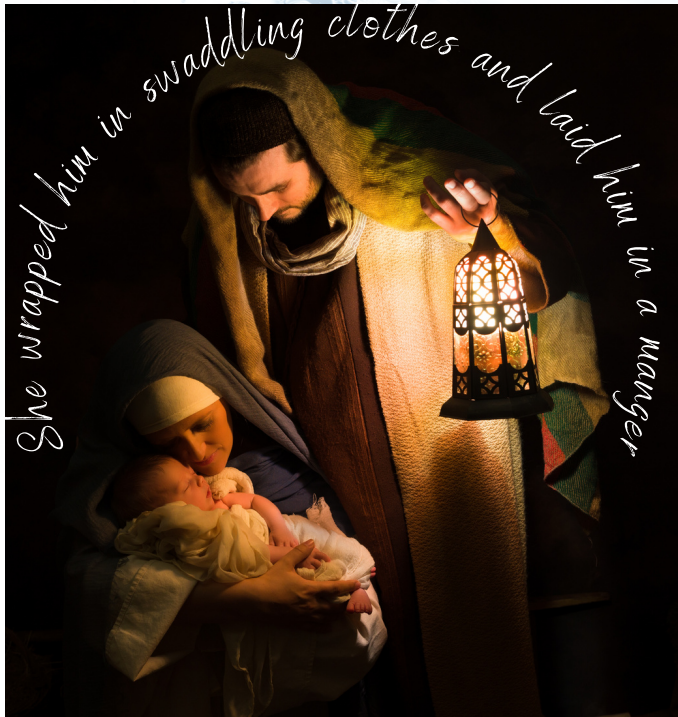

CHRISTMAS PRAYER OF LIFE AND JOY FROM THE CATHOLIC BIBLE INSTITUTE

Shepherds on a hill saw the light and heard the majesty of the Messengers of heaven proclaiming the coming of God into the world. They left that place and went to see in person this wondrous event. We do not know where they originated. It does not matter. God came to them where they were.

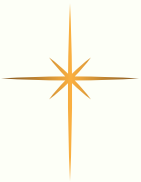
In this we are able to imagine the shepherds as people of faith who understood the message and acted upon it. They were not scholars of the Law, Prophets, and Writings, nor were they nobility. They were common folk who tended the flock, and it was to them that God chose to give the message of eternal salvation.

Most of us are not actual shepherds tending to actual sheep. It is through the signs and symbols in the birth story of Jesus that we can ask questions of our own lives: Are we shepherds? Are we Messengers? How are our lives revealed in the revelation of God with us? Who are we in the passion play?

As the Lukan and Matthean annunciation accounts show us, Mary and Joseph received the proclamation from the Messenger and quietly obeyed. They kept it all in their hearts. It was the shepherds who made the proclamation known to posterity. It will be visitors from the east who will announce it to the captains and kings, and we will come to understand viscerally that the reality of something beyond the world and so much greater brings both immense joy and intense fear.

I will not pretend here to ignore the warning signs in the world. How many other times in history have we entered into this place of trepidation and yet we get on with things?

Life is a gift from God, and it is our offering of gratitude to live it to its fullest, especially in times of darkness. We are coming into a time of darkness in the world but the light that is on the horizon is so much brighter than the imagination can contain. This is where we live.

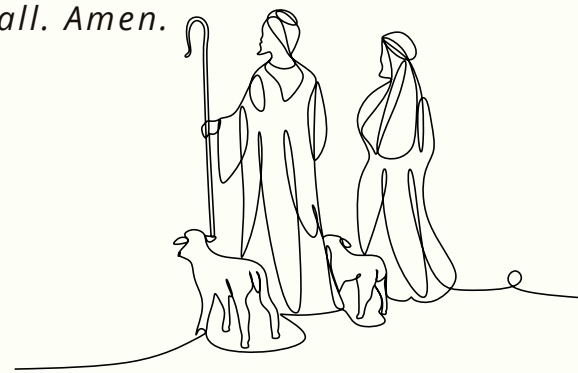

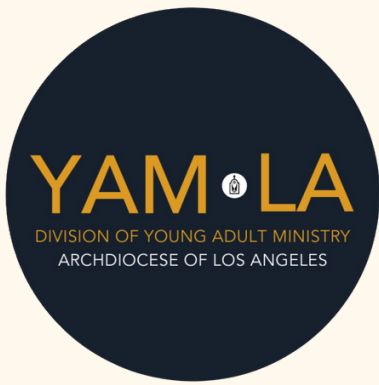

Global Celebration for Youth & Young Adults

At the end of Mass on the Solemnity of Christ the King on November 22, 2020, Pope Francis called for a renewal of the global celebration of young people (youth: ages 12-18 & young adults: ages 18-39) in the local churches in every diocese and eparchy. He also announced that, beginning in 2021, he would transfer the diocesan celebration of WYD from Palm Sunday to Christ the King Sunday. The next Global Celebration of Young People takes place on: **Sunday, November 26, 2023.**

To support that celebration, the USCCB has published a **National Pastoral Resource Guidebook for the Global Celebration of Young People.**

1. HEAR

2. TALK

In today's Gospel, Jesus uses the image of a vineyard to help people understand they are rejecting the love of God when they reject the message of Jesus. Today, many people do not want to live the way he showed us in order to be happy.

3. PRAY

Gather around your prayer space and light a candle if possible and/or available. Begin this moment of prayer by reciting together "In the name of the father, and of the son..." and signing yourselves with the sign of the cross.

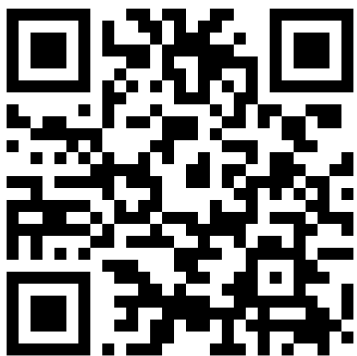
