2. PRAY

During the Easter season, we hear of the many occasions that Jesus appears to His disciples. Today, the disciples once again are greeted by Jesus' words, "Peace be with you" and a meal is shared. He speaks with them about the scriptures and invites them to go out and share what they are witnessing. For prayer this week you're encouraged to do so during a shared meal. Take time to:

- 1. Be still and read the psalm for today
- 2. Think of a person in your life who could hear about Jesus' life, love and mercy
- 3. Ask the Holy Spirit to give you courage to speak to them when appropriate

4. Close in a prayer of thanksgiving for the physical and spiritual nourishment God provides to your home.


