2. PRAY

Dialogue with Jesus

Have a moment of silence to talk with Jesus. To help you in this dialogue, you can use one of the following reflections:

"My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

- Under what circumstances have I felt abandoned, even by God?
- Can I hear the voice of Jesus? What is he telling me? What do I say to him?

Then Jesus cried out and breathed his last.

- Can I hear the voice of Jesus in the cries of my sisters and brothers who cry out for peace, for justice, for their basic needs, and to be treated with their God-given dignity?

Then the veil of the temple was torn in two parts from top to bottom

- What are the things in this world that separate me from God? From my brothers and sisters? What actions can I take to help remove the barriers that exist between people?

Conclude your dialogue with this prayer:

Grant me, O Lord, new strength not to let myself be carried away by my human weaknesses. Amen.



3. TALK

As a family, share something you felt deep in your heart from your dialogue with Jesus.

- Which word or words caught your attention?
- What part comforted you?
- Which part challenged you?

A family member prays this prayer aloud.

- Lord, we thank you for your Word that has made us see better the will of the Father. May your Spirit illuminate our actions and give us the strength to follow what your Word has shown us. Grant that we, like Mary, your Mother, may not only hear, but also put the Word into practice. Amen.
