- Now listen to what Jesus is saying to you
- Listen to Jesus say to you, "Your faith has healed you, go in peace."

- **My commitment for this week:** The text says, "If I only touch his cloak, I will be cured." This week try to visit the Blessed Sacrament to touch the "mantle" of the Tabernacle, staying in His presence for a while.
