1. HEAR

2. PRAY

Find a space where you can "recline" like the crowd in Gospel. For today's prayer, like Jesus, we invite you to be out in nature.

Specifically find a space where you can see a mountain or lay on grass as the crowd in the Gospel did. Be present with what you see, hear, feel, smell around you. After a few minutes, repeat this line from the psalm as many times as it feels right:

*Let all your works give you thanks, O LORD,
and let your faithful ones bless you.*

We invite you to finish your time of prayer by giving thanks to Jesus for the ways He has provided in your life today.

Dive deeper: Find space to repeat this process each day this week. Jesus is calling you to rest so that He can move!

3. TALK

Jesus called the 5,000 to recline, then he provided. Share with those around you what surfaces with the following questions:

- How have I seen Jesus multiply what I have been given?
- Where in my life am I being called to trust that God will multiply?
- What gifts can I give to Jesus for him to multiply?
