

# ADVANCED MINISTRY STUDIES—AMS

The Advanced Ministry Studies is a certification offered by the Archdiocese of Los Angeles Office of Religious Education. It is offered to Parish Catechetical Leaders: religious education coordinators, youth ministers, catechists, OCIA teams, baptismal formation teams, etc., Catholic School religion teachers/campus ministers, lay or religious ministers and to anyone working in any ministry or apostolate in the Church. This program will help participants to advance in their understanding of the teachings of the Catholic Church and be prepared for roles in different areas of church ministry.

#### PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The certification in Advanced Ministry Studies consists in three year process, each year runs from August to June with one Saturday on site or online class.

### THEOLOGY —THE PROFESSION OF FAITH YEAR

#### PARTICIPANTS WHO COMPLETE THIS PROCESS FOR CERTIFICATION WILL:

Be certified and commissioned in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles with one of the following certificates:

- ⇒ Archdiocesan Master Catechist (A discernment call to form catechists)

**FORMAT** The program is offered in a hybrid format, giving opportunities to experience in person and online teaching experiences. Participants are accompanied by a team of professors and mentors.
