

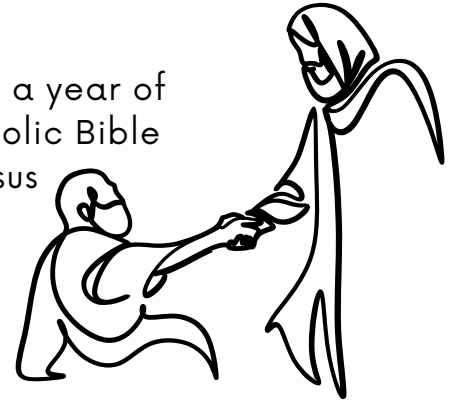

Recertification enrollment is reserved for those who have successfully completed all the requirements for Certification and have been commissioned by the Archdiocese of Los Angeles.

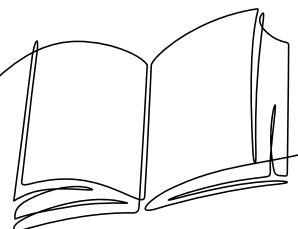
