The Archdiocese of Los Angeles is a tapestry of many peoples and cultures with a common thread joining us as one: one mission to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ and one Catholic faith to be believed, celebrated, and lived. **One Mission One Faith** is a basic ministry formation process for anyone who serves in the life of the Church.

The goal of **One Mission One Faith** is growth as a missionary disciple of Jesus Christ and formation as a parish minister. Participants will ground their ministry in a deeper understanding and intentional living of their Catholic faith. Participants can participate towards the California Catechist certification from the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, (Certification-Track) or they can participate for their ongoing faith formation (Enrichment-Track)

PARTICIPANTS WHO COMPLETE THIS PROCESS WILL:

- · Grow in love and knowledge of God
- · Understand the Word of God and basic Catholic teachings
- ·Integrate the Word and Catholic teaching with life, prayer, and ministry
- · Develop skills to serve effectively in ministry
- · Share their faith in Jesus Christ with greater clarity and confidence

EACH SESSION ENTAILS:

- · Video presentations
- · Readings
- · Written reflections
- · Prayer, small-group conversation, and Q&A (via live web conference)
- · Accompaniment by a team of facilitators

The process occurs within five to six months, one online session per week. (some sessions occur via live web conference) Integration sessions for prayer, small-group conversation, and Q&A occur between every few sessions via live web conference.
