STEPS TO BECOMING A CERTIFIED CATECHIST

- Complete the Theology Phase I - One Mission One Faith - OMOF
- Complete Phase II Vision and Skills for faith Formation (former known as Specialization) This is a preparation to develop catechetical and ministerial skills for sharing faith offered through the Office of Religious Education.
- Complete the Practicum Phase
 - Observation: Do two observations to gain experience and be enriched by other facilitation styles - certified catechists.
 - Evaluation: Be evaluated one time by a certified master catechist, certified catechist, Parish Catechetical Leader, or parish catechist recommended by PCL. All paper work needs to be uploaded to C3LEAD in the ADLA Certified Catechist Candidate learning path. <https://c3.leadlms.com>
- Recommendation for certification from Parish Catechetical Leader DRE/CRE/PCL by signing the catechist certification transcript.
- Assemble all completed paperwork, present it to your coordinator along with the Catechist Certification Progress Transcript form to be verified and signed by the coordinator on the Practicum Phase section.

Catechist Certification Paperwork

- Completion of Theological Phase - OMOF in C3LEAD or prior
- Completion of Vision and Skills - VSFF in C3LEAD
- Observation forms (2) - to be upload it to C3LEAD
- Evaluation form (1) to be upload it to C3LEAD
- Catechist Certification Progress Transcript (Final form to be signed)to be Uploaded to LEAD
